2. Update implementation

- 50.083 Apostilles issued as of 30th Sep.
- Out of which: 3.729 e-Apostilles
- 36 administrative and judicial Competent Authorities already issuing Apostilles under the new system
- Deployment in remaining judicial Competent Authorities in process
- Notaries: Preparing to join e-Register component





3. Legal framework

1. Royal Decree 2433/1978, designating Competent Autorities in Spain

- Currently under review, to be approved soon
 - Updates the scheme of Competent Authorities in Spain
 - Incorporates new advantages for applicants of Apostilles, overcome territorial division of competences for judicial and administrative Competent Authorities

2. Ministerial Order JUS/1207/2011, 14th May 2011

- Establishes and regulates the electronic Register of Apostilles of the Ministry of Justice
- Regulates the procedure of issuing paper Apostilles and e-Apostilles
- Recognizes the full validity in Spain of e-Apostilles validly issued in other Contracting States to the Apostille Convention.





4. Objectives of the Spanish e-APP system

- Develop a system usable by different authorities
- Expedite the issuance of Apostilles: faster and more quality service to the citizen
- Increase the guarantees linked to Apostilles
- To facilitate international circulation of public documents and reduce the chances of fraud.
- Allow comprehensive control of Apostilles issued in both electronic and paper through on-line verification (e-Register).



5. General features

Comprehensive e-APP system: two components

- e-Apostille: Allows issuing both paper Apostilles and e-Apostilles
- e-Register: Information available on-line regarding Apostilles issued in Spain through the new system.





5. General features

- Allows issuing both electronic Apostilles (e-Apostilles) and paper Apostilles
 - → E-Apostille for electronic public documents
 - → E-Apostille for public documents issued in paper that are digitalised (scanned)
 - → Paper apostille for paper public documents
- Apostille signed digitally (PAdES standard, advanced signature for PDF files)
- Apostille certificate used: trilingual version developed by Hague Conference

5. General features

- Common database of all signatures of Public Document Issuers: replaces paper samples in Competent Authorities
- Possibility to download e-Apostille online by the applicant within its validity period (30 days)
- Single e-Register of ALL Apostilles (paper Apostilles and e-Apostilles) issued in Spain










6. Public Document Issuers Signature Database

- Allows to create, delete or update records corresponding to Public Document issuers
- Data stored for every Public Document issuer:
 - Name
 - Post
 - Institution
 - Signature validity period
 - Scanned handwritten signature and stamp
 - Public key from digital certificate
- Integrates with e-Apostille for signature validation:
 - Name
 - Visual check of handwritten signatures
 - Automatic check of electronic signatures





7. Future Improvements

- A number of further developments envisaged, to be undertaken in phases.
 - a) On-line application of e-Apostilles.
 - Uploading of electronic public documents in order to apply for their Apostilles
 - On-line application for an electronic public document and its Apostille altogether

b) Signing e-Apostilles with a "Public Institution Certificate"

- "Public Institution Certificate": a special kind of server certificate owned by a Public Institution
- The main advantage in using this kind of certificate is that the whole process can be done with no human intervention



8. Products & Technology used

- Open Standards: J2EE architecture (Web Applications developed in Java running on WAS 6.1)
- Interoperability: SOA architecture (Web Services)
- RDBMS: Oracle 10g
- Standard Document Format: Adobe PDF
- Digital Signature Standards:
 - PAdES for signing e-apostilles
 - XAdES, CAdES & PAdES supported for Public Documents



9. Modularity and Exportability

- One of the main goals in designing the Electronic Apostille System was to enable re-use of its components by other Competent Authorities in Spain or in other countries
- As an example, the e-Apostille an e-Register components are integrated, but not coupled
- In a similar manner, other pieces can be replaced, meeting certain conditions.





9. Modularity and Exportability

- A given jurisdiction may adapt the Spanish system by replacing some of the components:
 - 1. Database Manager
 - 2. Digital Signature Component
 - Validation Code Generator
- Spanish e-APP software will be distributed to any interested State
 - Under European Public License: for Spanish e-APP software and open software components
 - Commercial products must be substituted by open software products or purchased



10. Experiences and lessons learned from the implementation of an e-APP system in Spain

Challenges

- Deployment in the entire national territory, in Competent Authorities under different jurisdictions
- Potential rejections/objections to the acceptance of Apostilles issued with the new system by jurisdictions more accostumed to paper

Opportunities

- Taking advantage of the possibilities offered by new technologies: new Royal Decree in process proposes to break the territorial division of competences for judicial and administrative Competent Authorities
- Increased advantages for applicants of Apostille (download of e-Apostilles)
- Progressive reduction of affluence of public at Competent Authorities, thanks to new telematic possibilities



10. Experiences and lessons learned from the implementation of an e-APP system in Spain

Lessons learned

- Training before deployment & technical support for users at the moment of deployment are of great importance
- Implementation of the e-APP in a given State might need legal coverage at national level
- -Information and Communication campaigns:
 - Competent Authorities.
 - Citizens/ applicants of Apostilles
 - Receiving authorities in third countries.
