Updated information on the Second Regional Meeting, Prague Czech Republic

Project funded by the European Commission

The e-APP for Europe is a transnational e-justice/e-administration project designed to develop best practices in relation to the Apostille Convention by promoting the e-APP, in particular the use of e-Registers of Apostilles. This is a joint initiative of the Permanent Bureau of the Hague Conference of Private International Law and the Ministry of Justice of Spain in association with the Ministries of Justice of Finland, France and the Czech Republic. The Project is funded by the European Commission under its "Civil Justice" programme. The 18-month project is comprised of three main interrelated elements: 1) The development and implementation of a central e-Register of Apostilles for all Competent Authorities in Spain; 2) The holding of three regional meetings across Europe to encourage all participating States to implement e-Registers (please see here for the Conclusions & Recommendations of the First Regional Meeting held in Helsinki on 14 February 2011); 3) The holding of the 6th International Forum on the e-APP (which took place on 29 and 30 June 2010).
